
- Relevance-** Is the SWOT relevant to the project's objectives?

- Feasibility of Mitigation Strategies-** Are the strategies for mitigating weaknesses and threats realistic and actionable?

## What is a SWOT Analysis?

Strengths:	Weaknesses:
Internal factors that give a company a competitive edge, such as skills, expertise, resources, or unique selling points	Internal factors that hinder an organization's performance, such as lack of resources, outdated technology, or insufficient training

Opportunities:	Threats:
External opportunities that can be leveraged for growth, like changes in the market, new technologies, or untapped customer segments	External threats that can negatively impact performance, such as increasing competition, changing regulations, or economic downturns
